# Abandoned Puppies Found in Milk Crate at The Humane Society of North Texas

### Adopt. Foster. Donate. Volunteer.

**Who:** A concerning incident took place earlier today at the Humane Society of North Texas. Surveillance footage captured the moment when an unidentified woman pulled a milk crate out of the trunk of her car and placed it next to the door before driving away. When staff came out to speak with a different person waiting, they discovered the crate containing 7 young puppies. The puppies, estimated to be around 3 weeks old, were left unattended.

Where: Fort Worth, Texas at the Saxe-Forte Pet Adoption Center

**Why:** We share this information to emphasize the importance of responsible pet ownership and proper avenues for rehoming animals. We urge individuals to seek assistance from animal welfare organizations rather than resorting to abandonment, which can endanger the lives of vulnerable animals.
