Humane Society of North Texas Receives Lifesaving Kitten Formula Donation from Orphan Kitten Club

OCTOBER 4, 2024 | FORT WORTH, TEXAS – The Humane Society of North Texas (HSNT) is proud to announce a generous donation of kitten formula from the Orphan Kitten Club, enabling the organization to save and care for hundreds of vulnerable, bottle-fed kittens. Since receiving the donation of five large buckets of formula on August 5th, HSNT has already supported over 50 “bottle babies,” ensuring that young, fragile kittens in North Texas have access to the vital nutrition they need.

The donation will sustain HSNT’s bottle-feeding program over the next six months, providing enough formula to support an estimated 200 kittens. Kitten formula is a costly and often hard-to-find resource, making this donation invaluable to the shelter’s efforts.

“Thanks to the Orphan Kitten Club’s generous donation of kitten formula, our shelter has been able to welcome more bottle babies without the constant worry of running out of supplies,” said Destiny Vandeput, Director of Communications for HSNT. “Having enough supplies readily available has eased the stress on our staff and fosters, enabling us to focus on lifesaving efforts rather than resource limitations. This reliability has also helped our efforts to intake more kittens from local municipal shelters, boosting their live release rates. We are deeply thankful for the Orphan Kitten Club’s ongoing partnership and commitment to saving lives in our community.”

With this support, HSNT is positioned to take in more kittens from local municipal shelters, helping increase live release rates and offering second chances to more animals in need.
